- Whereas,*** Jayanthi Narain '07, UGA honor student and UGA Foundation Fellow, has represented herself and the UGA community with outstanding performance and achievement; and
- Whereas,*** Jayanthi, a graduate of Central High School in Macon Georgia, has pursued learning and leadership from her years as a young student; and
- Whereas,*** while dual majoring in international affairs and economics, Jayanthi has minored in French and Arabic; and
- Whereas,*** Jayanthi was involved in an HIV Aids education program in schools of Malawi, Africa the summer of 2006, allowing her the opportunity to serve the needs of children; and
- Whereas,*** as an intern for Heritage Watch in Cambodia, Jayanthi worked to preserve the cultural legacy of Cambodia and the Southeast Asian people; and
- Whereas,*** while studying Arabic, Middle Eastern politics and economics in Cairo, Egypt, Jayanthi taught English to refugees and helped educate the children of a Sudanese family who did not attend school; and
- Whereas,*** her public service activities, including her work with the UGA Model United Nations team and Amnesty International, allowed her to express her concern for genocide and women's rights. Jayanthi also founded STOP, a group focused on sexual violence awareness at UGA;
