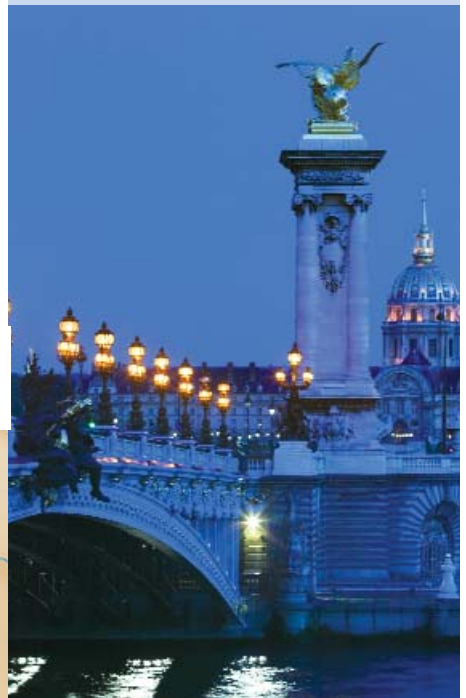

PARIS

PARIS AND MONTMARTRE

A wonderful orientation to Paris! Notre-Dame Cathedral, a priceless gem of Gothic architecture. The Champs-Élysées with its ceremonial Arc de Triomphe. Les Invalides where Napoleon is buried. The Place de la Concorde, steeped in historical magnificence. The iconic Eiffel Tower. Montmartre, home to singers, writers and painters from everywhere. The glorious white multi-domed Sacré-Coeur Basilica. If you had only one day in Paris, this would be the way to spend it.

THE LOUVRE MUSEUM

Enjoy one of the largest art collections in the world at the Louvre. This former royal palace and fortress is home to many masterpieces including the famous Mona Lisa, the Winged Victory of Samothrace and the beautiful Venus de Milo.

MOULIN ROUGE, DINNER AND SHOW

A night to remember at one of the most famous nightclubs in the world, the Moulin Rouge Cabaret. As evening falls the spirit of La Belle Époque embraces you and the cancan dancers Toulouse-Lautrec painted come to life.

VERSAILLES, GIVERNY AND MONET'S HOUSE

A treat for the artist in everyone. The magnificent Hall of Mirrors at Versailles, site of the signing of the World War I peace treaty and sumptuous royal suites with original decor dating from 1662. Follow the Seine River to Giverny to visit the charming house and spectacular gardens that inspired so many of Claude Monet's impressionistic masterpieces. See Monet's studio and the famous Japanese bridge. An art lover's dream.

LONDON

WEST END AND CITY OF LONDON

A great overview of London. See the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Trafalgar Square, Buckingham Palace and the colorful changing of the guard. After visiting the West End continue on to the City of London passing the Stock Exchange, Bank of England and Mansion House topped off with a guided tour of Westminster Abbey. The day culminates at the Tower of London, the 900-year-old fortress that has served as a royal palace and an infamous prison.

WINDSOR CASTLE

See the home of British sovereigns for nearly 900 years. Windsor is the world's largest inhabited castle and the Queen's weekend home. Visit the state apartments which house works of art by Van Dyck, Rubens and Rembrandt. Enjoy time at leisure in the delightful town of Windsor with its cobbled streets, tea rooms and shops.

STRATFORD AND OXFORD

A day in the heart of the English countryside. Travel to Oxford, the thousand-year-old "City of Dreaming Spires" whose streets are framed by the stone walls of the colleges. Visit one of the renowned campuses that comprise Britain's oldest university town. Continue to Stratford-upon-Avon, birthplace of Shakespeare. See the romantic old thatched cottage where William wooed and won his beloved Anne Hathaway as well as discovering the modern delights of this busy market town.
