CHRISTIAN ROME AND VATICAN CITY

A trip to the Vatican Museums will be an awe-inspiring experience as you take in the artistic genius of the Renaissance. The Sistine Chapel thrills with its majesty and the brilliance of Michelangelo's Genesis and Last Judgment. Stroll St. Peter's Square and take in the size and beauty of St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the world. Visit the church of St. Paul Outside the Walls with its richly decorated facade of mosaics, considered to be one of the most beautiful in Rome.

MONUMENTAL ROME

They say all roads lead to Rome, and when you breathe in this glorious city that vibrates with history, you'll know why. A walking tour includes the spectacular Colosseum, the ancient remains of the Forum, and the Trevi Fountain, Rome's most famous fountain. ORVIETO

Discover the charms of Orvieto perched on a volcanic plateau. This enchanting city is well-known for its white wine, finest olive oil and variety of handcrafts. Its quaint streets are lined with colorful ceramic products and wrought ironware. Explore the medieval Duomo, among the greatest of Italian Romanesque-Gothic cathedrals. FLORENCE DELIGHTS

Best known as the "Cradle of the Italian Renaissance," Florence is a city with overwhelming historical and cultural significance.
